Melvin Earl Villaver Jr. remixes academia with Hip Hop, transforming beats into scholarship and history into rhythm. As an Assistant Professor of Audio Technology and Global Black Studies at Clemson University, his work bridges Black music, technology, and Afro-Asian collaborations. His Harmonic Resurgence mixtape evolved into a live halftime show with Clemson University's 300-piece Tiger Band, blending Hip Hop with the pageantry of marching ensembles. Published in College Music Symposium and The Asian Caribbean in the Caribbean Diaspora, he moves fluidly between the archives and the studio, always posing the question: What is the sound—past, present, and future—of freedom?
