
The Women's Roundtable is a developmental and networking opportunity for participants to acknowledge, explore, and invest in the promotion of the experiences of girls and women, particularly in STEM fields. The Women's Roundtable brings participants together to emphasize the importance of education, self-care, and preservation. It also focuses on the tools and skill sets necessary to cope with and navigate exclusionary educational and professional environments that many girls and women encounter.

ATTENDEE STATS:

The inaugural Women's Roundtable was held in 2021 with more than 350 participants, increasing to 500 attendees in 2022. The 2023 event welcomed 614 event participants, a 75% increase since its inception.

Attendees of the Women's Roundtable include students from middle school, high school, and college, as well as business professionals from corporate and non-profit sectors.

In 2023, 93% of attendees reported that they are likely to attend another event and 94% indicated they have a strong likelihood of recommending Women's Roundtable to a friend.
