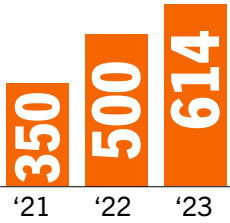
# EMPOWER. CONNECT. THRIVE.

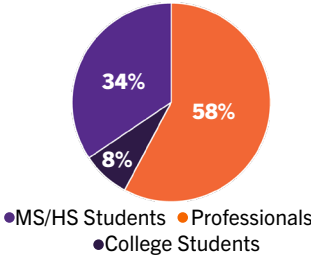


### ATTENDEE STATS:

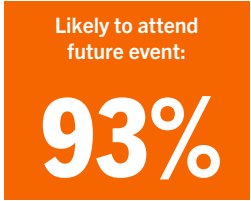
The inaugural Women’s Roundtable was held in 2021 with more than 350 participants, increasing to 500 attendees in 2022. The 2023 event welcomed 614 event participants, a 75% increase since its inception.



Attendees of the Women’s Roundtable include students from middle school, high school, and college, as well as business professionals from corporate and non-profit sectors.



In 2023, 93% of attendees reported that they are likely to attend another event and 94% indicated they have a strong likelihood of recommending Women’s Roundtable to a friend.

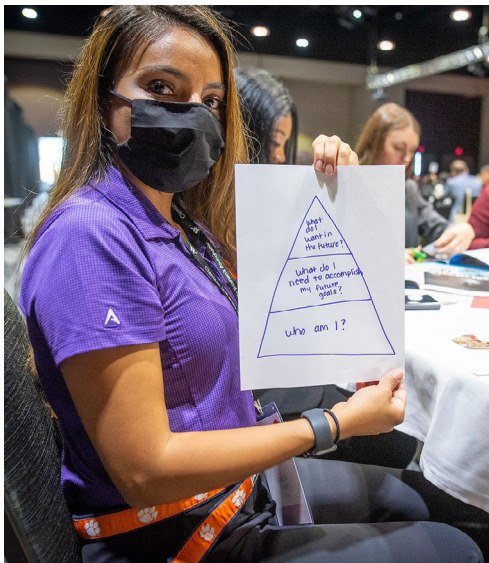
