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Application for Special Admission

Special Student Status

The special student classification is designed for students not interested in pursuing a degree at Clemson University. A maximum of 18 total credit hours is allowed either in a single semester or cumulatively over several semesters or summer sessions. None of the usual credentials supporting an application are required. Your application will be processed within 5-10 working days. It is not necessary to reapply for special student status if you enroll in concurrent semesters. Do not confuse part-time enrollment with enrollment as a special student. Apply for regular admission unless you desire to take a cumulative total of no more that 18 credit hours.

Applicants who have been denied regular admission to Clemson are not eligible to apply as special students.

You are considered a transient student if you are currently attending another institution and wish to transfer the credit back to that institution. Transient applications for Maymester and Summer Sessions I & II are available in the Registrar's Office in 102 Sikes Hall. You should apply as a special student if you plan to attend Clemson in the fall or spring semester.
