### **Practicum Assignments, Fall**

- One Introductory Visit by US, can be virtual by US (between weeks 1-2)

- \*Weekly Lesson Plans (due each Friday by 5:00pm, September 6 – November 29, to US)
- \*Four Lesson Observations by US (1 in September 2 in October, 1 in November)
- \*Three Lesson Observations by CT (1 in September 1 in October, 1 in November)
- \*Midterm Self-Assessment (due October 9 to US; may need to create improvement plan)
- \*Final Evaluation by US (CT and US collaboratively complete)
