Dr. Richard Ringeisen passed away on February 18th. From 1979-1993 he was head of Department of Mathematical Sciences at Clemson University. He served as Dean and Chancellor at Old Dominion and East Carolina Universities and was Chancellor Emeritus at The University of Illinois Springfield. In retirement, he loved to play golf with the Walker Course senior group and continued to play despite his battle with Parkinson's. He is survived by his wife, Carolyn, two children, and six grandchildren.

Winter Update

January and February were a bit drier than the last couple of years which was nice. We did have two cold snaps that required covering of greens. There was a third cold snap where we considered covering, but because of several factors – warmer soil temperatures, good soil moisture, and the short amount of time below freezing – we elected not to cover.

Our Winter project work has gone well, but we still have several things we would like to accomplish before the growing season starts. One thing of note was the re-decking of the bridge near 2 green. Another was the replacement of a collapsed drainage pipe on 16. We took advantage of the course being closed due to the greens being covered to do this work.

18th Hole

The 18th hole is finally complete. Finally! Other than a little mulch to spread and an irrigation controller to relocate, we are done. The temporary path has been removed, all the sod is down, and the wall is complete. The new fountain has been installed, is operational and looks great, especially at night.

Driving Range Relocation Project

The driving range project is in full swing. Right now, it just looks like a big pile of dirt. We are at the mercy of the parking lot contractor to complete certain phases of their work so that our golf course contractor can get on with building the practice greens, tees, and target greens and install irrigation and drainage throughout. We are still hopeful for an August opening.

March Goals

March will be a busy month for the maintenance staff as things warm up. Goals include:

- Spreading Spring fertilizer and pre-emergent.
- Mow down all the rough to remove dead material and keep the rough from being too thick and fluffy.
- Complete the end of our winter project work.
- Transition to routine mowing as the grass emerges from dormancy.
- Spreading mulch in beds throughout the course.

Home Lawn Tip

Now is the time to apply a pre-emergent herbicide to control summer annual weeds such as crabgrass and goosegrass. Crabgrass begins to germinate when the soil temperatures are at or above 55 degrees for 3 days, and we are right at that threshold.
