# Ways to Ask for Student Feedback OTE

Ask for feedback early & often  $\checkmark^{\Re}$ 

Canvas Survey or Qualtrics (Anonymous is key!)

## **CLEAREST POINT & MUDDIEST POINT**

Best for **content understanding** and could be used during class or at the end of class.

Question Example: What is the clearest point from this week's lesson? What is the muddiest point?



#### **START - CONTINUE - STOP**

Best for **mid-semester** check in on what instruction or studying adjustments need to made. Good for student reflection too!



Question Example: What is something that I should **continue** doing that is helping you learn well? What is something you should **start** doing to help you study more effectively for the next exam?

### **GENERAL CHECK IN**

Best to do a **few times a semester** and ask for general class experience and student well-being.

Question Example: *How confident are you feeling now that we are a month into the semester?* 



#### **1 MINUTE REFLECTIONS**

Best to be used for brief understanding of content or on teaching.



Question Example: ?What is 1 specific thing that I did in this lecture to help you understand the material

> \*Pose the question and set a timer for 1 minute. After a minute collect responses.\*

#### **PULSE CHECK**

Best for very quick, informal check in on how students are feeling about a new or upcoming topic.

Question Example: What is 1 word that describes how you are feeling about the new topic that we will start next class?
