

## PCO BUSINESS LICENSE VERIFIABLE EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENT FOR DCA

All applicants for a South Carolina Business License must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Department of Pesticide Regulation that the certified Category 7A applicator in charge, Designated Certified Applicator (DCA), has either a four-year college degree in the natural sciences or two years of verifiable experience in any area of pest control, including sales and termite treatment. Additionally, before the Pest Control Operator Business License can be issued, the DCA must be duly licensed and must operate from the applicant's location.
